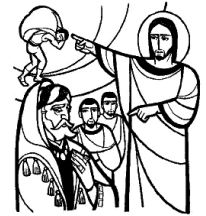
**Rosary at Fort DeRussy:** During the month of October Rosary will be prayed at 4:35 prior to the 5:00 mass.
